



Are You a Trans, Gender Diverse or Questioning Student?

KNOW YOUR RIGHTS

All students have the right to...

- 01 Be referred to with your chosen name and pronouns by staff and peers;
- 02 Use the bathroom, change room and other gendered spaces of your choice, and participate in the gender segregated groups where you are most comfortable, when gendered spaces are required;
- 03 Feel safe from harassment, bullying and microaggressions;
- 04 Not be outed by school staff to peers, family members, parents or guardians without your consent;
- 05 Express your gender identity and expression, including non binary identities, in whatever way makes you feel safe and comfortable
- 06 Connect with your community!
